If the base verb ends in one of the sounds /t/ or /d/, then it's pronounced /id/ (visit – visited, need - needed). If the base form ends in one of the sounds /p/, /f/, /s/, /ʃ/, /tʃ/, /k/, then it's pronounced /t/ (wash – washed, kick – kicked).

If the base form ends in one of all the other sounds, e.g. /v/, /1/, /r/, etc, then it's pronounced /d/ (sail – sailed, climb – climbed, rain - rained).
